This summer he was invited to perform with The National Youth Orchestra of The United States of America (NYO-USA) and tour North America, performing at various concert halls under the direction of Sir Andrew Davis. He plans to pursue music performance and begin study at a conservatory this fall. Outside of music, he enjoys the outdoors and spending time at the river with his family.
